



The Required Documents for Bankruptcy Filing

- _____ Car titles for ALL vehicles in your name.
- _____ Deed(s): Must have recorded information noted on deed.
You must get copies from the County Clerk's Office.
- _____ Mortgage(s): Must have recorded information noted on mortgage.
You must get copies from the County Clerk's Office.
- _____ Judgment liens (if any). Must have recorded information noted on judgment liens.
You must get copies from the County Clerk's Office.
- _____ Federal and State Income Tax Returns for the last two (2) years.
- _____ ALL bank statements (checking AND savings) for six (6) months to the date of filing.
- _____ Divorce Decree and Settlement Agreement.
- _____ One copy of each of your most recent bills (credit card bills, medical bills, collection letters, check cashing).
- _____ ALL paystubs for six (6) months up to the date of filing.
- _____ Copy of Social Security Card AND copy of Driver's License.
- _____ Other documents may/will be required to file bankruptcy. I understand my bankruptcy will not be filed unless I provide the above listed documents and any other documents requested by my attorney.
